**General Information:**

\* Show begins at 8:30. The main arena opens at 7:30 for warm up but no fences are to be jumped; warm up fences will be available in the warm up arena and our new warm up classes will help you get going.

\* Classes will be split by age if entries warrant, and may be canceled or combined if less than 3 entries. Longing is permitted, but only if the arenas are not crowded (probably only 1st thing in the morning).

\* Jumpers may enter classes 1-4, 3 -6 or 5 - 8. Hunters may enter any two consecutive divisions or, with a rider change, may enter non-consecutive divisions.

\* Ribbons to 5th place, with Championship Prizes in each Division. You must enter and show in at least 3 classes in the division to be eligible for the Championship.

\* Warm-up classes do not count toward the Division Championship, but the class will be judged and prizes awarded. Those wishing to receive coaching assistance during the Warm Up Class may elect not to compete.

\* All shows will be held in an outdoor arena, so weather IS a factor in determining if the show will be held. Entry Fees: \$10 per class to pre-enter; \$15 per class day-of-show. Also, drug fee \$5 per horse per show day.

\* As this show is being held to support the activities of MHA and the stewardship of Sequoia Arena, MHA Membership is required to compete – or you may choose to pay a non-member fee of \$12/day.

\* Pre-enter: Mail to 40 Sharon Ave, Piedmont, CA, 94611 or fax to 510-428-1025 before May 27, 2008.

\* Informal (but neat and clean) attire. Helmets (with harness for juniors) and boots are required at all times.

\* Trailer parking is amidst the Redwood trees. We will have parking assistance for you. Please be sure to park close (but at a safe distance!) to other rigs so that we will have room for everyone.

\* Shallow community water troughs available – or bring your own water buckets.

\* Food and beverages will be available for sale.

\* This is a City of Oakland Park; please conduct yourself accordingly. Dogs must be leashed at all times.

\* Scratches refunded with certificate from doctor/veterinarian.

\* Photographer will be on the grounds.

\* Directions: From Highway 13, Take the Lincoln Ave/Joaquin Miller Exit. Go east (uphill) on Joaquin Miller to the traffic light. Follow the signs for Chabot Science Center, which will direct you to turn left onto Skyline Blvd. Follow Skyline up the hill for 1.2 miles to the sign for Sequoia Arena on your left. Turn into the driveway, then turn right. Look for parking attendant before parking your rig.
