Great American/USDF Qualifying classes (Q) classes are run concurrently.

Fees: Intro and Opportunity: \$35, Training: \$40, 1st – 4th Level: \$45, FEI and Freestyle, \$50 Pas de Deux: \$50. Add \$10 to normal class fee for Great America/USDF Qualifying and submit documentation to verify eligibility to enter the class.

Awards: Ribbons 1st through 5th, prize to 1st in classes with three or more horses.

Stabling: There is no stabling on the grounds. Limited local stabling. Contact organizer for location and cost.

Veterinarian and Farrier on call, information posted at announcer's stand

Entry Deadline: One week before show date. Refund for cancellations until deadline. After deadline: Vet or Doctor's certificate or fill space for refunds. \$10 fee for refunds. Late entries through Tuesday, if space allows. \$10 late fee. No post entries. \$25 fee for returned checks. Incomplete entry fee \$10.

Riding times available Thursday before show. **Call Manager.** Riders should be prepared to ride at any time as classes may be scheduled out of order.

Show will close early if oversubscribed. Entries may be limited to two rides per horse /rider combination. Management reserves the right to arrange for an additional judge.

Directions: From South: I-580 to Oakland, exit Hwy #13 (Warren Fwy);
From East: Hwy #24, exit Hwy #13 south;
From North: I-580 south, exit Hwy #24 east (Orinda), exit hwy #13 south.

From hwy #13 (Warren Freeway) take Joaquin Miller/ Lincoln Ave. exit. Go east, up the hill on Joaquin Miller Rd. (Follow signs to **Chabot Space & Science Center.**) At the top of the hill, turn left at the stop light on to Skyline Blvd. and proceed uphill into the park. **Sequoia Arena** is about 1.5 miles on the left. (Just before Chabot Space and Science Center.)

Sequoia Arena: Located in the Oakland Hills, in Joaquin Miller Park, is surrounded by pine trees. The climate is temperate. Sometimes foggy. The arena is standard (20m x 60m) with sand and warm up area is sand.

There is creative parking under the trees.

There are bleachers next to the arena.

Lunch will be available as well as snacks and drinks.

Video taping and photography will be available.

Dogs must be on leash.
