From Highway 13 in Oakland,
exit **Lincoln Ave/Joaquin Miller Rd.**
Follow signs to Chabot Space and Science
Center.
Go east (uphill) on Joaquin Miller to the traffic
light. Turn left onto Skyline Blvd. and go up
hill into the park about 1.1 miles.
Turn left at the sign for Sequoia Arena.
Look for parking attendant for instructions
about parking your rig.

General Information:

* Show begins at 8:30. The main arena opens at 7:30 for warm up. Lounging is permitted in the warm-up arena only if there are no riders present.

* Show management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel any classes. The judge's decision is final.

* Prizes to first. Ribbons to 5th place. High point ribbons for each age division.

* All shows will be held in an outdoor arena, so weather IS a factor in determining if the show will be held. Entry Fees: \$10 per class to pre-enter; \$15 per class day-of-show. Also, drug fee \$5 per horse per show day.

* As this show is being held to support the activities of MHA and the stewardship of Sequoia Arena, MHA Membership is required to compete – or you may choose to pay a non-member fee of \$12/day. Join now to enjoy member benefits for the rest of the year.

* Pre-enter: Mail to Kathy Dunn 13223 Clairepointe Way, Oakland, CA 94619; or drop off at Vista Madera Feed & Tack before June 18, 2010.

* Informal (but neat and clean) attire, boots are required at all times. ENGLISH: Helmets (with harness for juniors) are required at all times when mounted.

* Trailer parking is amidst the Redwood trees. We will have parking assistance for you. Please be sure to park close (but at a safe distance!) to other rigs so that we will have room for everyone. Please clean up after your horse; take your manure and hay with you.

* Shallow community water troughs available – or bring your own water buckets.

* Food and beverages will be available for sale.

* This is a City of Oakland Park; please conduct yourself accordingly. Dogs must be leashed at all times.

* Scratches refunded with certificate from doctor/veterinarian.

* All riders/handlers must sign a Liability release.

* All show fees must be paid in full before leaving.

About Joaquin Miller Park

Situated in the Oakland Hills, Joaquin Miller Park contains one of the only Urban Second Growth Redwood Groves in existence. The Save the Redwoods League donated the Redwood Grove to the city of Oakland in 1928. Joaquin Miller Park is named for one of the late 19th century's more colorful figures. Self-proclaimed "Poet of the Sierras" Joaquin Miller was a pony-express rider, lawyer, judge, teacher, gold prospector, nomad, author, and one of California's first environmentalists.
